

ORDINANCES FOR THE AWARD OF MEDALS TO GRADUATING STUDENTS

A student may be considered for the award of an institute medal only if

1. He/she has cleared all the prescribed courses of the concerned semesters in the first available chance.
2. No disciplinary action was taken against him/her by the Institute during his/her entire academic career in the Institute.
3. He/she has obtained a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of at least 8.0 at the end of the final semester of the programme.

The following medals shall be awarded to the students who fulfill the above criteria as well as criteria given below:

- Chairman's Gold Medal
- Institute Gold Medal

(1) Chairman's Gold Medal

The Chairman's Gold Medal will be awarded each year to the student who stands first securing the highest CGPA among all the students of the batch receiving the Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech) in that year.

In case of a tie in the CGPA, the medal will be awarded to the student who has earned the highest number of credits with 10 grade points, followed by JEE(Main)/AIEEE score in case of a tie again. In case of a tie further, the Chairman's Gold Medal will be awarded to the students, getting equal CGPAs even after applying the additional criteria.

(2) Institute Gold Medals

The Institute Gold Medals, one for each of the disciplines under BTech, Master of Science (MSc) and Master of Technology (M.Tech) programmes of the Institutes will be awarded each year to the student who ranks first, obtaining the highest CGPA among all the graduating students in his/her discipline in that year.

In case of a tie in the CGPA, the medal will be awarded to the student who has earned the highest number of credits with 10 grade points, followed by JEE(Main)/AIEEE score for B.Tech, GATE score for M.Tech, and BSc % marks for MSc in case of a tie again. In case of a tie further, the Institute Gold Medal will be awarded to the students getting equal CGPAs even after applying the additional criteria..
